Dear Mr. Crutchfield:

Reference 1 provided Louisiana Power & Light Company's response to Issue 16, transmitted via reference 2. In the response, LP&L committed to a review of initial LP&L interviews and exit interviews prior to exceeding 5% power. This activity has been completed.

LP&L engaged Quality Technology Company to manage a Quality Team effort for Waterford 3. One of the Quality Team responsibilities was to review interviews which had been conducted by LP&L prior to the formation of the Quality Team. These interviews included initial interviews of QA personnel in January 1984 and exit interviews subsequently conducted through July 1984. The Quality Team was directed to analyze the interviews thoroughly for additional potential concerns and the cause and generic implications of all concerns, to follow-up on matters deemed to require further information, and to open a file for each individual's concern expressed and document specifically their dispositions.

The Quality Team has completed the review of the subject interviews and has issued a comprehensive report of the findings and conclusions. The report concludes that "...Issue #16 is satisfactorily resolved and will have no adverse effect on the safe operation of Waterford 3." The subject report is on file at the Waterford 3 site and is available for review by the NRC Staff.


