The Office of Inspector and Auditor's inquiry into the information enclosed with your memorandum of December 27, 1983, did not substantiate any wrongdoing by [redacted] a contract consultant to the CAT. We interviewed both [redacted] and [redacted] the electrical contractor at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant. Both individuals asserted that [redacted] never discussed with [redacted] the contents of the interviews of Comstock QC inspectors that [redacted] conducted during the August-September 1983 CAT inspection at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant.

Our interviews of [redacted] and [redacted] also determined that although both men worked together for several months in 1982 for the Enrico Fermi Nuclear Power Plant in Detroit, Michigan, they were employed by Detroit Edison and not by the L.K. Comstock Company as alleged.

Three Reports of Interview obtained during our inquiry are attached. The Office of Inspector and Auditor plans no further action on this matter.
