This refers to an investigation performed by the NRC Office of Investigations (OI) at your Fermi 2 nuclear facility. The subject of the investigation was a concern regarding the deliberate attempt to compromise portions of an NRC operating license requalification examination. Additionally, two other potential wrongdoing issues were investigated. It was concluded that a Fermi 2 lead instructor had deliberately attempted to compromise the NRC requalification examination. We have separately reviewed and are satisfied with your corrective actions with regard to this deliberate compromise. The other two concerns were not substantiated. A copy of the Synopsis of the OI Investigation case No. 03-91-010 is enclosed with this letter.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
