Report of Interview

[REDACTED] L.K. Comstock Company, the electrical contractor at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant (NPP), was telephonically interviewed concerning his recollection of conversations he had with [REDACTED] Contract Consultant, Office of Inspection and Enforcement, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), during the Construction Appraisal Team (CAT) Inspection at Perry NPP, between August 22 - September 2 and September 12-23, 1983.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] worked together for several months in 1982 at the Enrico Fermi Nuclear Power Plant in Detroit, MI, where they were employed by Detroit Edison as contract consultants. Therefore, when [REDACTED] came to Perry NPP as part of the CAT inspection team, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] talked about old times. Additionally, during the CAT inspection, [REDACTED] discussed with [REDACTED] the items he was inspecting in order to obtain the information necessary to conduct the inspection. These discussions were normally held in the presence of [REDACTED] inspection partner, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] never discussed "inspection findings" with [REDACTED] on a one-on-one basis.

During the inspection [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] interviewed several L.K. Comstock QC inspectors. [REDACTED] recalled one occasion when he and several QC inspectors were sitting in a large, open office near [REDACTED] office when [REDACTED] came into the room. [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] how the interviews were going and [REDACTED] replied in a joking manner, "You're really a slave driver." [REDACTED] reply was obviously made in jest and was heard by everyone in the room. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] never discussed the content of interviews conducted of QC inspectors by [REDACTED]. In [REDACTED] opinion, [REDACTED] conducted his portion of the CAT inspection in a very objective and professional manner.
