SUBJECT: ADDITIONAL CONCERNS OF A PRIOR ALLEGER,  
MR. STEVE BALAZS

At 1:45 P.M. on Thursday, January 12, 1984, I received a phone call at the Resident Inspector's office from Mr. Steve Balazs. Mr. Balazs informed me that he had sent a letter to Mr. Peter Block, the Chairman of the ASLB for the Perry facility. He stated that his letter disagreed with the affidavits submitted by Mr. Emanuel Riley and Mr. Dick Bower in a recent motion to reopen ASLB hearings on the Quality Assurance program of the site electrical contractor, L. K. Comstock.

Mr. Balazs stated that he felt he was a fool to expect CEI to do anything. He further stated that he had a lawyer and had been advised to turn over his concerns/information to the NRC as he was required to do so under 10 CFR 50. He indicated that he was willing to go as far as it took to get things corrected.

I requested that Mr. Balazs send his notebook or a copy of same to Region III to the attention of Mr. Charles Weil along with a copy of his letter to Mr. Peter Block.

Mr. Balazs indicated that he had received two registered letters from Ms. Susan Hiatt of O.C.R.E. He indicated that he wanted nothing to do with them as they wanted to stop the plant, but he just wanted it built right. He further indicated that three additional QC inspectors for LKC had just quit.

I told Mr. Balazs that Region III would be in touch with him after reviewing his information and requested his home phone number
