While preparing the Supplemental Response provided by Reference 3, MP&L noted that the subject title on the previous responses (References 1 and 2) denoted the responses were applicable to Grand Gulf Nuclear Station Units 1 and 2. We wish to clarify that the results of snubber inspection and testing described in the letters applied only to Unit 1, since, due to the construction status, it was not and is still not feasible to inspect and test Unit 2 snubbers. The preservice inspection procedure used for Unit 1 applies to both units. We are tracking Unit 2 commitments to perform preservice inspection and testing of snubbers related to IE Bulletin No. 81-01, Revision 1, on our licensing commitment tracking system.
