SUBJECT: CONTRACT COST REPORTING FOR LICENSE FEES

As we discussed with you yesterday, we agree with your proposed concept of collecting contract costs for license fee casework. I would like to emphasize that NMSS wants cumulative costs since the inception of the case displayed in the monthly progress letters. This will ease the reporting burden for NMSS project managers and improve the accuracy of the data reported to the LFMB. We plan to officially submit NRC staff hours and contract costs to the LFMB at six month intervals as required by the new rule. We do not object to your reporting contract costs to LFMB on a monthly basis as long as they are aware that it is not official information and has not been certified by the NMSS project manager.

Under the proposed, ^{new} fee schedule, applicants for waste disposal, waste storage and field flooding tracer study licenses will be charged on the basis of actual hours expended rather than a flat fee.

Program Support has asked us to dream up a system to do this. Currently the fuel and transportation license applicants are charged on the basis of actual time. In a interim response to PSB, I suggested that for the few materials licenses which will be charged on actual time, the cases be entered into the PSB PPSAS (paywork system).
