By letter of August 9, 1984, Boston Edison proposed an amendment to Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station's technical specifications. This proposed amendment, in part, modified existing technical specifications concerning torus water temperature monitoring instrumentation, and included into technical specifications new instruments associated with post-accident monitoring.

Based on the October 3 and October 12, 1984 telephone discussions between the NRC and Boston Edison concerning the amendment, Boston Edison requests that, in accordance with NRC recommendations, Containment High Radiation (Torus) instrumentation be removed from Table 3.2.F, and that the minimum number of operable instrument channels for Containment High Radiation (Drywell) be changed from 1 to 2.
