Gentlemen:

This letter is to provide special information concerning admittance of NRC contract personnel scheduled to visit the Cooper Nuclear Generating Station from October 22, 1984, through November 30, 1984, for the purpose of observing decontamination operations for their research program.

The contract personnel identified in the attached Special Enclosure will require unescorted and unrestricted access to the administrative offices, the protected areas, and vital areas (excluding CAS and SAS) in order to conduct their observations.

We request that a site orientation relevant to the issuance of badges, escort duties, and emergency evacuation be afforded those personnel listed, if such training has not previously been provided. Other NRC personnel may, at your option, be given a special indoctrination sufficient for them to have unescorted access to the protected area.
