REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF FEE

International Nutronics, Incorporated is currently under two Orders which suspend all use of licensed material and require a complete decontamination of their facilities in Dover, NJ. A closeout survey report and request for release for unrestricted use for an ancillary building not used for purposes listed on the license and not explicitly described on the license has been received from the licensee and reviewed by Region I. Region I believes that a formal license amendment documenting the fact that the ancillary building is not contaminated and can be released for unrestricted use should be issued in this case in light of the outstanding Orders.

We believe that cleanup and release of the building for unrestricted use is in the public interest. Further, since a license amendment would not necessarily be required, and since the formal documentation of the status of the facility is in the NRC's interest, we request that the fee for Control No. 02194 be waived.

Your consideration of this matter would be appreciated.
