STEAM GENERATOR TUBE REPAIR Subject:

> At 3:44 a.m. (CDT) on October 21, 1984, the licensee began an orderly shutdown of Unit 1 after it was determined that a tube leak in the "B" steam generator was leaking an estimated .309 gallons per minute. (Technical Specifications allows a maximum leakage rate of one gallon per minute.)

The resident inspector was at the site to observe the shutdown. Cold shutdown was achieved without incident at 8:48 p.m. (CDT) October 21, 1984. The licensee has begun preparations to locate and plug the leaking tube. Shutdown is expected to be greater than 48 hours. Region III will monitor the licensee's actions.

The State of Minnesota will be notified.
