MEMORANDUM
(Raw Data on U-Bolts)
We appreciate the speed with which Applicants responded to our Memorandum and Crder of nctober 18, 1984 concerning raw data for U-Bolts. Although we had requested the data on short notice, we had not intended to impose unduly, believing that the raw data for Applicants' finding would be at hand. Had we been asked, a reasonable extension of time could have been granted.

On the other hand, the data filed yesterday are not the "raw data" we requested. We have been provided with a "Torque-Average (ft-1bs)," which does not permit us to examine the variance of readings on individual bolts. Furthermore, this data does not provide us with any indication of the procedure used to measure torque--in particular, whether it was measured by tightening or by loosening. We really want the raw data. Furthermore, we request the procedure that would help us to know how the readings were taken and the criteria for selecting the sample. (If there were any readings taken that were excluded from the sample, we also request the raw data on those readings.)
