Thank you for your response of July 26, 1984, to our Notice of Violation issued on June 27, 1984, concerning activities conducted at your Crystal River facility under NRC Operating License No. DPR-72. We have evaluated your response and found that it meets the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201. We will examine the implementation of your corrective actions during future inspections.

While your corrective actions appear acceptable, a statement in your response concerns the NRC as it reflects a philosophy that your management policy supports an anticipated error rate with regard to procedure compliance. Management at all levels should project and expect procedural compliance from those they supervise.

During the enforcement conference held on September 6, 1984, the NRC management was reasonably assured that your management is applying the proper attention to this area.
