This refers to the routine resident safety inspection conducted by Mr. G. Walton of this office on July 24 - August 24, 1984 at the Beaver Valley Power Station, Unit 2, Shippingport, Pennsylvania of activities authorized by NRC License No. CPPR-105 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Walton with Mr. Majumdar and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the NRC Region I Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that one of your activities was not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A. This violation has been categorized by severity level in accordance with the revised NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C) published in the Federal Register Notice (49 FR 8583) dated March 8, 1984. You are required to respond to this letter and in preparing your response, you should follow the instructions in Appendix A.

In addition to the apparent violation discussed above, the results of this inspection indicate that certain of your activities have not been conducted in full compliance with your commitments made in a meeting on May 17, 1984, and followup letters 2ASR-01126 and 2ASR-01135, as set forth in the Notice of Deviation, enclosed herewith as Appendix B. You are requested to respond to this deviation in the matter outlined in Appendix B.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.790(b)(1). The telephone notification of your intent to request withholding, or any request for an extension of the 10-day period which you believe necessary, should be made to the Supervisor, Files, Mail and Records, USNRC Region I, at (215) 337-5223.

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The responses directed by this letter and the accompanying Notices are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.

Your cooperation with us in this matter is appreciated.
