



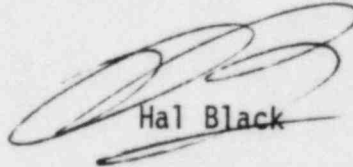

SUBJECT: FINAL RULE CHANGES FOR 10 CFR 170

We have reviewed the subject document and have the following comment in response to Enclosure B. The third paragraph of Enclosure B does not permit reporting "Voluntary" overtime by employees. By not reporting voluntary overtime, it will be difficult to get a complete picture of how much time has actually been spent on a project. Such data are useful in program planning and budget formulation. Therefore, we suggest that procedures for reporting of voluntary overtime be incorporated in the final Bulletin.

In response to this request, I told him fee ranges for Category IC were based on a combination of historical data and management estimates. Most facilities currently possessing licenses under this category were licensed prior to 1970 when more stringent environmental requirements were necessary. Therefore, fees for new applications were based on management estimates with ranges dependent on hearing time, quality of the application, responsiveness of the licensee, location of the plant, knowledge available for environmental assessment. Estimates for amendments and renewals were based on a combination of experience and management estimates considering the above factors. This info was provided by W Burkhardt, FC.
