SUBJECT: PROPOSED FEE CATEGORIES 3H, 3I, 3J AND 3K

Nate Bassin contacted me today concerning the question we raised about the differences in the proposed fees for the subject categories. Nate confirmed that the review effort required for applications covered by proposed fee Categories 3H and 3J is greater than the review effort required for applications covered by proposed fee Categories 3I and 3K, even though the safety evaluations are charged for separately (proposed fee Categories 9A and 9C). Therefore, the proposed fees in Categories 3H, 3I, 3J and 3K are correct. Nate also said it would be appropriate to collect three separate fees for applications that would fall in fee Categories 3A or B, 3H or J, and 9A or C, since three separate reviews are required.

SUBJECT: PROFESSIONAL STAFF HOUR DATA

I recently completed a detailed analysis and review of IE computer data provided by the regions and IE headquarters relating to the issuance of four operating licenses (McGuire 2, San Onofre 3, St. Lucie 2 and Summer 1). In three of the four cases the data to be reviewed covered a ten-year period. Specifically, the activity codes used by the professional staff in the regions and headquarters to charge hours to the four specific dockets were reviewed. In each of the cases, a determination was made as to whether the hours shown in the computer reports should be included in the operating license fee assessed or excluded from fee recovery under the March 23, 1978 license fee schedule. The activity codes for the four cases are listed below and are identified as included for license fee recovery or excluded from license fees.

SUBJECT: ADP REQUIREMENTS FOR LFMB REPORTS TO SUPPORT NEW
LICENSE FEE RULE

Attached are the computer specifications and sample output formats that support our needs for license fee billing under the new rule.

To assist us in administering the license inspection fee program, we request two modifications to the regional inspection report tracking system. These modifications involve no additional inspector or data entry time over that which is currently planned.

Modification 1

Please provide a single digit flag that can be set to indicate that an inspection report number must be reported on the 6-month "Facilities Under Review" report (LFMB #2). This flag will be set only if the report number was posted prior to the OL issuance date and the inspection is not yet completed (no date is present in the letter to the licensee field). Once set, this flag will remain set permanently.

Modification 2

Please provide a date field for date inspection cancelled. This date should be system generated just like the date posted field. Once set, the inspection cancelled date will remain permanently on file in each region's inspection report system.

Inspection Fee Summary Report
Quarterly Summary - Operating Facilities
(LFMB #1)

This report is a quarterly report shown as Attachment 1. It will be run using data parameters which the operator must enter (From-To). There will be a docket key list (as Attachment 2) by region which must also be accessible for list by LFMB staff. Even though the docket key list is region specific and the output is region-by-region, data collection for this report must look over the entire data base of all regions to be certain to include any other region's contributions on that docket inspection report. This report must list only completed inspections and scan back to the beginning of RWAT/RITS manpower records to ensure that all hours on that docket/inspection report number are displayed. Report numbers change annually (e.g., 8405 vs. 8501). Activity codes for the data rows of LFMB #1 are as follows:

Routine

Preparation - AIP, APP
Inspection - ACI, AII, API, BA1, BB
Documentation - AID, APD

Reactive

Preparation - ARP
Inspection - ARI, BA2, BD2
Documentation - ARD

The hours on this report must be regular hours only. Non-regular hours should not be selected. The IMI codes entitled "Allegation and Hearings" must be backed out of any hours collected for this report and for all reports.

The licensee name and address must be displayed using the agency facility file. In the cases where facility name is not available the space should be left blank. The "Fee Per Report" is the product of the "Report Totals" and the constant \$53. The field of "Total Inspection Fee" is computed by summing the individual "Fees Per Report" and printing the total. The fields "Contractual Services" and "Total Fee" should be left blank. All dollar figures should be rounded to the nearest whole dollar.

During a docket search on this report, if no completed inspections are encountered on that docket number, the user must be notified that "no completed inspections encountered this quarter" and the docket number must be displayed. I recommend a single page of dockets listed that have no completed inspections logged to them in the quarter.

This report must not show inspections that have been cancelled or flagged as reportable on the 6-month report (see OL conversion program). A sample logic flow diagram has been made and is attached as page 3 of these instructions.

This and all LFMB reports must select only certain personnel. This is accomplished by selecting only data coded by staff who have the following position identification codes (PIC)...

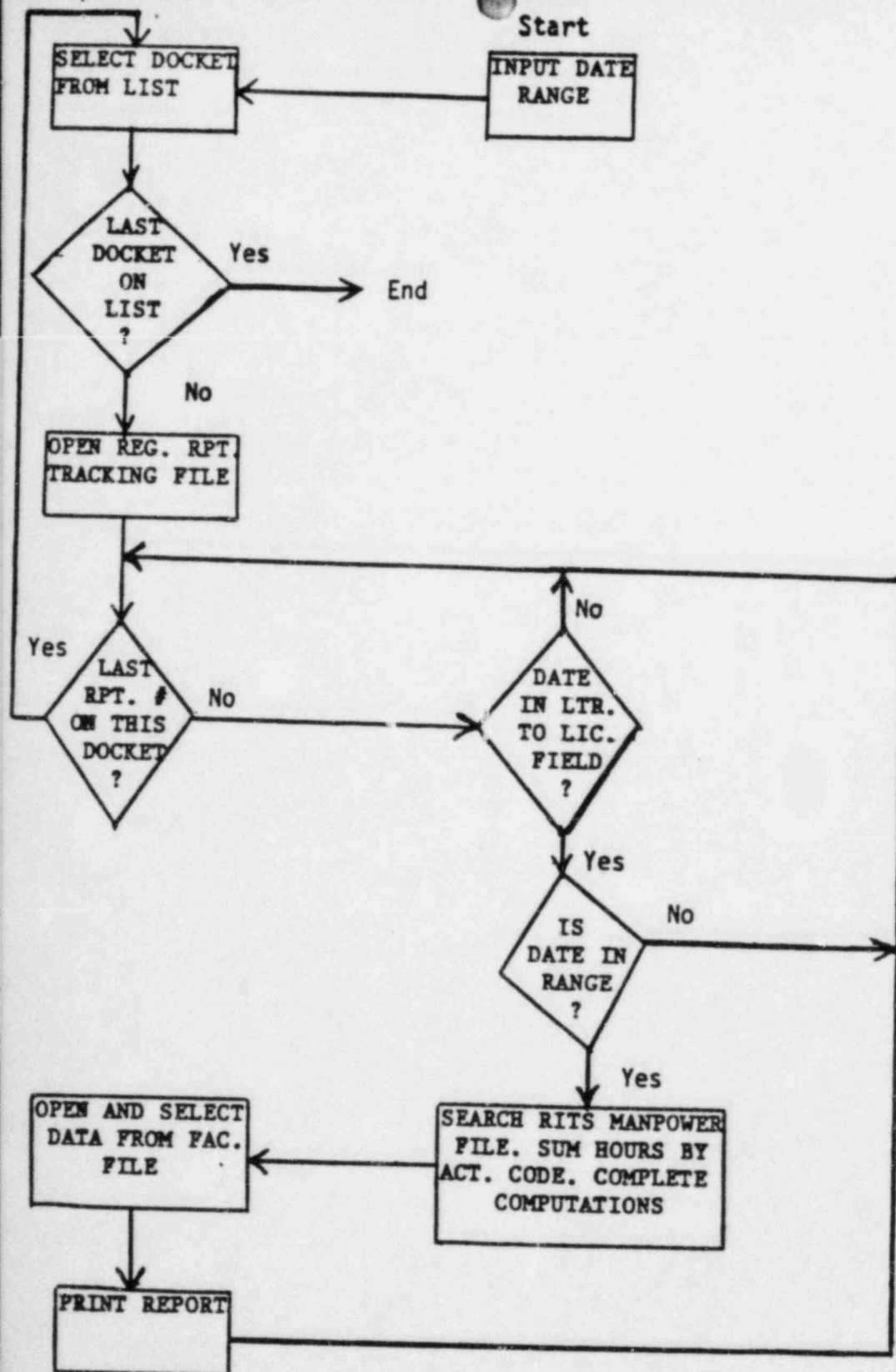

OL CONVERSION REPORT

When LFMB is advised that an operating license has been issued, this program will be executed. It must run against regional inspection status tracking systems to place a flag on an inspection report number to indicate that this report number must be shown only on the 6-month summary, and not reported on the quarterly report.

Parameters to be keyed into this program are the OL date and docket number. Output from this program will be:

A. A list of inspection report numbers associated with the docket number (keyed in) that have start dates prior to the OL date (also keyed in) and do not have a date in the letter to licensee field (open inspections).

B. A list of inspection report numbers that have start dates after the OL date.

In the case of A above, the program must flag these inspections to be reported on the 6-month reports (LFMB #2, #3, or #5). It must additionally move the docket number from the LFMB #2 docket list (Attachment 4) to the LFMB #1 docket list (Attachment 2) for future quarterly reporting.

In the case of B above, the inspections that have begun after the OL date was entered, should be left unflagged so that LFMB #1 and LFMB #4 can report them. LFMB #3 will report all inspections on file.
