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

SUBJECT: PROFESSIONAL STAFF EFFORT FOR CESSAR-80

I have reviewed the data recorded on MPS and have determined that IE employees (HQS and TTC staff, and those PAT staff located in Regional Offices) did not record any routine inspection efforts devoted to CESSAR-80 (docket #50-470) during the period 10/20/78 to 12/21/83. IE's contract specialist reviewed the available contract files and could find no records of any contractual costs expended in support of routine inspection at CESSAR-80 during this time period. During the period we did not keep records of consultant costs devoted to specific licenses (for whatever purposes), but it is highly unlikely there were any.
