
Dear Dr. Glenn:

This ammendment application is to allow Aeonic Systems to transfer all the provisions of its current license to a new location. The new location is next to our current location in a building of the same general construction and size. The reason for the change is our company has grown to the point that our existing facility is too small for our needs. We are moving into our new facility on February 1, 1985.

As is shown in the attached floor plan, the new facility will have more floor space than our current location. In my judgement there are no changes in the radiological protection aspects as a result of this move. All procedures and precautions employed in the past will still be followed after the move.

I would appreciate early approval of this ammendment as we have building leases involved with this move and need to make it on February 1.
