SUBJECT: Allegation Regarding Irregularities in Comanche Peak Radiographic Operations

At approximately 09 5 this date, the writer was contacted by telephone by a person who would identify himself only as "John" with some interesting allegations regarding site radiography operations.

- a. Changing the film automatic processor speed so as to get the correct film density.
- b. "T" holes in penetrameters have been reamed to a larger size to give the appearance of adequate film sensitivity.
- c. Defective welds have been masked out when shooting adjacent thin wall repairs.
- d. Others

"John" indicated that he could be contacted at [REDACTED] I told "John" that I would forward the allegation to the Region IV office and that either Herr, Driscoll or myself would get in contact with him in the near future.

"John" stated that he was still employed at the site but was scheduled for termination on October 1, 1982 which was why he refused to give his last name.

Assuming that "John" is currently employed a radiographer (as he stated), I have deduced that his name is John Lunsford thru the use of the personnel roster and site telephone directory. [REDACTED]
