My name is Gary Alford, and I have been employed by Brown & Root at Comanche peak for about two years. I presently work in electrical termination, but during my first year on the job I worked on Robert Messerly's pipe hanger crew.

During the time I worked on the crew I do not know of anyone using a cutting torch on a hanger without proper authorization. I remember seeing torches used on hangers especially a large "saddle" hanger on elevation 885 in Unit I reactor. I do not know if the crew had a CMC <sup>OK</sup> for the cuts made on this hanger, but I assume they did because we worked on that one hanger for several months. During the time I worked on Messerly's crew I do not recall anyone asking me to do work out of
