

Statement of
Rex Alan Broome

My name is Rex Broome, and I have been employed by Brown & Root for about seven years and nine months. I am presently a pipe fitter, but I have worked as a pipe rigger at Comanche Peak.

I believe it was the summer of 1981 when I was told to help relocate one loop of the main steam pipe in Unit 1. The polar crane was used to make the vertical lift of the pipe, and I used come-alongs to pull the pipe laterally to its proper position. When this pipe was moved it was connected at the penetration in the containment wall, but was not connected at the other end.

The main steam pipe was relocated and we left the pipe restrained laterally until the final hook-up with the steam generator was made.

There was a temporary flush pipe ~~cut~~ cut before we made ~~the~~ movement of the main steam line.

The main steam pipe was moved I believe because it had settled out of position, and had to be put back in place for the final connection to the steam generator. During the movement of the main steam pipe with the polar crane there was an engineer directing the operation and monitoring the weight taken by the polar crane.
