I was involved in the evaluation and relocation of the main steam line number ^{TMC MS-1-01-1303-2} ~~_____~~ on Unit I located within the containment building. I was present during the movement of this pipe using the polar crane to insure that activity was within proper engineering limitations for the equipment.

This main steam line was connected at the penetration in the wall of the containment, but was not attached to the steam generator. This line was raised several inches vertically to compensate for sag in the temporary supports used to support the line during the ^{construction} ~~Flushing~~ ^{operation}. The Flush line was cut prior to the relocation of the main steam line. I believe that during the time the main steam line was being raised, there was also a horizontal realignment ~~to~~ the line by pipefitters working

earings. I conducted discussions with
the engineer and the engineers to
determine that movement of the steam line
was acceptable.

To my knowledge the relocation of the main
steam line was accomplished successfully,
without damage to any of the hardware,
and within the engineering parameters
involved.
