My name is Edwin Dean, and I have been a Brown & Root employee for about four years and nine months. I presently hold the position of general Foreman over hangers.

I recall an ^{ED} incident involving the movement on a loop of the main steam line in Unit I a couple of years ago. I had a hanger crew working in the area, but not on the steam line. I remember the polar crane was used to move the main steam line and that they were using come-a-longs also. I instructed my crew to move out of the way for safety. The foreman of this crew was Robert Messerly. ^{ED}

I do not know who was in charge of relocating the main steam line or the particulars of the operation. My crew on that elevation was not involved with the operation.
