


Billy Ray Jones

My name is Billy Ray Jones, and I have been employed by Brown & Root, the construction contractor at Comanche Peak, for about six and a half years. During 1979 I worked on Robert Messerly's crew installing hangars. I know that prior to that time Messerly had been in charge of the crew that handled Drillco "rebar eaters". During my employment with Brown & Root I have only had one occasion to use a rebar eater and that was to grind out a Hilti bolt that pulled out under torque.

I do not know of any instances where Drillco rebar eaters were used without proper engineering documentation. I do not know of any instances where supervisors have instructed craft personnel to cut through rebar without proper documentation.
