

Statement of

Ronald Dean McLee

My name is Ronald McLee, and I have been employed by Brown & Root for about seven and a half years. My position with Brown & Root is pipe fitter.

During the ~~summer~~ first part of 1982, I was involved in the relocation of the main steam line on one of the loops in Unit I. A portion of the pipe had settled and had to be lifted back into its proper location. Engineers were brought in and evaluated the effect of the proposed lift on the junction of the main steam line at the penetration in the containment wall. These engineers directed the use of the polar crane, and the line was lift vertically a few inches and was pull over laterally to its correct position, then resupported. I ~~do not~~ remember ~~if~~ the temporary flush pipe from the main steam line was cut before ~~or after~~ the lift, ~~and~~ the traveler package would document this. I remember helping cut the temporary flush line after the flush was completed. To my knowledge the realignment of this main steam line was done with engineering approval, and no damage was inflicted on the related equipment. I do not believe the line was left under tension when I have read the foregoing statement consisting of 1 handwritten page. I have made and initialed any necessary corrections and to the steam foregoings statement is true and correct. Signed on 5-5-83 at 1:35 pm.
