5 MR. CHILK: The first one deals with SECY-85-31.
6 That is a staff recommendation to release previously safe-
7 guarded materials pertaining to Shoreham

8 In this paper, the Commission is being asked to act
9 on an order that would release previously safeguarded materials
10 relating to physical security contentions in the Shoreham
11 low power proceeding.

12 All the Commissioners have approved an order which
13 releases ten of the documents in their entirety and three in
14 part.

15 Would you please affirm your votes?

16 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Aye.

17 COMMISSIONER ASSELSTINE: Aye.

18 COMMISSIONER BERNTHAL: Aye.

21 MR. CHILK: The second one is SECY-85-1. It is a
22 policy statement on the training and qualifications of

1 dated on the 6th. All the Commissioners have approved the
2 policy statement as we have attached it. Commissioner
3 Asselstine made some modifications which were not approved by
4 a majority. However, he still approves the policy statement.

6 COMMISSIONER ASSELSTINE: Aye.

7 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Aye.

8 COMMISSIONER ZECH: Aye.

9 COMMISSIONER ROBERTS: Aye.

10 COMMISSIONER BERNTHAL: Aye.
