This preliminary notification constitutes EARLY notice of events of POSSIBLE safety or public interest significance. The information is as initially received without verification or evaluation, and is basically all that is known by the Region II staff on this date.


SUBJECT: CRACK IDENTIFIED IN CORE SPRAY SPARGER/DISTRIBUTION BOX WELD
The licensee has identified a crack at the toe of the sparger/distribution box weld during inspection of the lower "B" core spray sparger on Unit 1. The crack appears to be in excess of $180^{\circ}$ of the circumference. The depth of the crack has not been determined.
The licensee reports that the upper core spray sparger exhibited no signs of cracking. Spargers were inspected on Unit 2 during its last outage, and no cracks were identified. Region II will perform follow-up inspections to assure proper resolution of this event.
Media interest is not expected. Neither the licensee nor the NRC plans to issue a news release at this time.
