SUBJECT: MEETING SUMMARY - VOGTLE FACILITY, DOCKET NOS. 50-424 AND 50-425

This refers to the management meeting conducted, at your request, in the Georgia Power Company office on September 14, 1984.

This meeting was conducted as a followup to the meeting held on September 6, 1984, to allow further discussions between NRC and Georgia Power Company on the readiness review concept development. The program concept was to be presented by Georgia Power Company to the NRC staff in Bethesda, Maryland on September 21, 1984.

The Readines. Review Program as presented by Georgia Power Company would consist of the development of approximately 20 Readiness Review Modules. The modules will be based on requirements, work process logic, the schedule sequence of work completion, and the time period available for review. Each module will undergo a four phase process of preparation/evaluation by Georgia Power Company, presentation by Georgia Power Company to NRC, package Work Review by NRC, and resolution/acceptance by NRC.

Georgia Power Company considers that the application of NRC resources to review and determine that the modules are acceptable are essential to the success of the program.

An interim decision was made by NRC to further discuss this matter with the Georgia Power Company. It was stressed that this is not a joint development project but one where the licensee is detailing how NRC regulations are specifically implemented and the NRC will objectively review to determine acceptance. A second point made by NRC is that the FSAR and its review for licensing will be a separate function and is not replaced by this program.

It is our opinion that this meeting was beneficial and has provided for a better understanding of your proposed changes.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of NRC's "Rules of Practice," Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room.

Should you have any questions concerning this matter, we will be pleased to discuss them.
