SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT 50-416/96-03

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. M. Runyan of this office. E. Girard of Region II. T. Scarbrough of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, and an NRC consultant on January 22-26 and February 12-16. 1996. at the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station facility. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether activities authorized by the license were conducted safely and in accordance with NRC requirements. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you and those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

The inspection involved a review of the activities performed by your staff to complete your commitments made in response to Generic Letter 89-10, "Safety-Related Motor-Operated Valves Testing and Surveillance." Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records and interviews with personnel. The results of this inspection are documented in the enclosed report.

We found that you have satisfactorily completed your commitments to Generic Letter 89-10; therefore, the NRC's review of your Generic Letter 89-10 motor-operated valve program is closed. This closure is contingent on your commitment, confirmed during the exit meeting held on February 16, 1996, to take actions prior to the end of Refueling Outage RF-08 to enhance the operating margins of two motor-operated valves discussed in Section 1.7.2 of the enclosed report. If your understanding of the commitment is different from ours, please notify me immediately. The completion of that commitment will be verified during a future NRC inspection.

The inspection also identified that your motor-operated valve program used several analytical techniques and assumptions that were not consistent with those employed by other nuclear utilities. During the inspection, your staff agreed that some of these assumptions and methodologies will require additional verification.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice." a copy of this letter and its enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

Should you have any questions concerning this inspection, we will be pleased to discuss them with you.
