Dear Mr. Woody:

The enclosed Maintenance and Surveillance Program Plan is being forwarded to the NRC Executive Director for Operations (EDO) for his approval. The Technical and Regulatory Issues discussed in the Plan are identical to those contained in the Draft Plan which I forwarded to you on August 7, 1984. The principal modifications to the earlier draft involve identification and coordination of related Staff Programs and phased implementation of tasks. The Plan discusses, in general, staff coordination with and evaluation of NUMARC and INPO activities as well as staff interaction with various other industry and standards groups. I request that your presentation to the EDO on October 25, 1984, include your comments on the Plan and whether additional detail is needed concerning staff coordination and evaluation of NUMARC/INPO initiatives.

As we discussed last week, I recommend that you provide a letter or other appropriate documentation which describes the various NUMARC/INPO activities planned and underway to address concerns identified by the staff in the Maintenance and Surveillance Program Plan.

A copy of this letter and the enclosed Maintenance and Surveillance Plan is being placed in the Public Document Room. I am encouraged by the NUMARC/INPO proposals discussed at our August 21, 1984, meeting and am looking forward to a productive meeting between NUMARC and the EDO.
