## TOPIC

The applicant presented his plan for the resolution of several site specific security hardware installation issues. Discussions during the meeting contained Safeguards Information and are, therefore, to be withheld from public disclosure as specified in 10 CFR 73.21.

#### SUMMARY

The applicant presented proposed plans for final resolution of the following security hardware installation issues:

- O Closed circuit television coverage of perimeter isolation zones.
- 0 Physical characteristics of isolation zones.
- 0 Placement and installation of certain types of mechanical sensor switches.
- O Special measures for the protection of sensitivity controls of security equipment.
- O Special security measures related to discontinuation of construction of Unit 2.
- 0 Security measures for securing openings in barriers.

Decisions reached during discussions will be incorporated in the next revision of the security plan to be submitted to the NRC for review and approval prior to operating license issuance.

Specific details of the discussions have been determined to be Safeguards Information as described in 10 CFR 73.21 and are being withheld from public disclosure.
