ORDER

Suffolk County and the State of New York have asked the Commission to stay its February 12 authorization for low-power operation of the Shoreham Nuclear Power Plant, or, in the alternative, to extend the administrative stay granted in our February 12 immediate effectiveness ruling. CLI-85-01.

Petitioners' request for a stay is denied.

Petitioners' request to extend the administrative stay, which is currently scheduled to expire on February 19, 1985, is granted, in part. In order to allow more orderly briefing in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals and in order to give that Court an opportunity to thoroughly consider the issues raised in the stay motion filed before

it, the Commission hereby extends its administrative stay of Shoreham's low-power operating license to 5:00 p.m. on February 25, 1985.
