The Board reopens the record for the sole purpose of admitting into evidence the Staff's Safety Evaluation Report (NUREG-1019) and Supplement No. 1 thereto.

During the course of the hearing, for some reason, the Staff offered, as its Exhibit 1, only certain pages from the SER and offered, as its Exhibit 2, only certain pages from the Supplement No. 1. However, 10 C.F.R. § 2.743(g) requires that the Staff offer the SER into evidence. Moreover, in preparing its Initial Decision, the Board found it necessary to advert to License Conditions in the SER and the Supplement which the Staff requests be imposed upon the Licensee, but which are not reflected in Staff's Exhibits 1 and 2.

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Accordingly, the Staff's SER is admitted into evidence as Board Exhibit 1 and Supplement No. 1 thereto is admitted in evidence as Board Exhibit 2. The Board will furnish three copies of each exhibit to the hearing reporter for marking and filing with the NRC Docketing and Service Branch. All parties and the Board have been previously served with one copy of each exhibit.

The reopened record is now closed.
