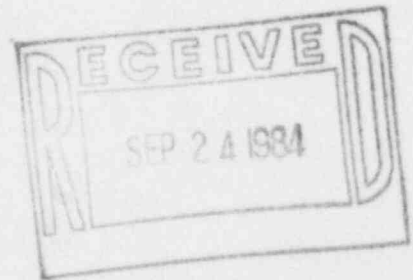

Dear Mr. Collins:

This letter provides Louisiana Power & Light Company's response to the NRC letter in Reference 1. In Reference 1, clarification of the statement "excluding parking lots", as used in item 8.1. of Reference 2, was requested.

The parenthetical statement "excluding parking lots" refers to those individuals not permanently assigned to the Waterford 3 Site, who may not have current training and are enroute from their vehicles to the owner-controlled area access point. Personnel that have assigned work areas in the parking lots (such as Security) are subject to the minimum training requirements for owner-controlled area access.
