MEMORANDUM (Documents About James Cole)

CASE's motion for production of documents, dated October 10, 1984 shall be granted. CASE has good cause for late filing because they were unaware of Mr. Cole's role in the "liner plate incident" until September 1, 1984 and because they made this request within a reasonable time after their document reviewer gave them a reason to seek discovery. Furthermore, any lateness in seeking discovery is offset by late disclosure of documents by Applicants with respect to other discovery requests. The test for appropriateness of discovery is found in 10 CFR §2.740: whether "the information sought appears reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence."
