In your letter of October 29, 1984, you continue to object to providing the support for your statement to the Licensing Board that the Majority Staff Report was based on independent hearings and investigations only available to other investigators. So be it. At this juncture with only two weeks to commencement of the hearing and in view of your threat to challenge the parties' existing stipulation on evidence which I believe could result in a substantial delay of the proceeding, Licensee will not file a motion to compel a response by TMIA to Licensee's Fifth Set of Interrogatories. It is obviously in Licensee's interest to avoid further delay and get on with the proceeding.

At some point, it may be that trying this case will not have the attendant time pressures on Licensee that I believe attach here. I look forward to that scenario.
