SUBJECT: PROPOSED CONTROL BUILDING ANNEX

On August 28, 1984, members of NRC staff and representatives of SCE&G met to discuss two proposed designs for a new Control Building Annex. The security aspects of both proposals were discussed relative to changes which could be made to the Physical Security Plan under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p). The Regional staff agreed to discuss certain equivalency aspects of the proposals with the Office of Nuclear Materials Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) staff. The Regional staff recommended that after the licensee decides which proposals they will construct that they meet again with the Regional staff. At that meeting, the licensee should have a written 10 CFR 50.54(p) change which would address the construction activity, compensatory measures, and licensee commitments relative to permanent security requirements associated with the Control Building Annex.
