Gentleman :

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Greenman of this office on August 28-29, 1973 at Oyster Creak, Forked River, New Jersey of activities authorized by AEC License No. DFE-16, and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Greenman with Messre. Reeves, Riggle and Sullivan of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Regulatory Operations Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with plant personnel, and observations by the inspector.

During this inspection it was found that certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of AEC requirements and another activity appeared to raise a question concerning the safety of operations. The items and references to the pertinent requirements and to generally accepted guidance are listed in the anclosures to this letter. This latter constitutes a notice sent to you pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.201 of the AEC's "Rules of Fractice", Part 2, 74 the 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Section 2.201 requires you to submit to this affice within 20 days of your receipt of this notice, a written statement of explanation in reply, including: (1) corrective stops wich have been achieved; (2) corrective stops which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be schieved.


