JEPSEY CENTRAL OYSTER CREEK 1, DOCKET NO. 50-219

Mr. Ivan Finrock, Vice President, New Jersey Central Power & Light Company, called me on Monday, August 13, 1973. The purpose of Mr. Finrock's call was to obtain the latest information on what ^{informer} the papers have because he has a ~~rather~~ major meeting with local residents in Lacey Township on their Forked River Project. This meeting is with the local governing body (some council).

He reviewed with me briefly what material he had and stated that there was additional information in the papers which he was unaware of. This ^{was} ~~is~~ a difficult subject for me to respond to, but since documentation is in the hands of the press, I discussed the important subjects that he might be hit with. I defended Chick Gallina and said he was guiltless in this area and said that he was totally not responsible for the press coverage. The items I discussed were not different from what was contained in the papers. Mr. Finrock said he had no problem ~~with~~ with Dr. Gallina. I was pleased to hear this.

Mr. Finrock terminated the conversation by stating that he hoped that he would get copies of any ^{information} of the press ^{gets} ~~hits~~ in the future, hopefully not items like the material the press got on this recent environmental issue. I assured him that he would get copies of everything that was made available to the public, promptly.
