Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 2
Request for Additional Information - NUREG-0737, Item II.D.1

In Reference (1) the Staff requested that Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) provide additional information concerning NUREG-0737, TMI Item II.D.1, performance testing of relief and safety valves. The information requested included questions related to the selection of transients and valve inlet conditions, questions related to valve operability, questions on thermal-hydraulic analysis, and questions on structural analysis. The Staff requested the NNECO provide responses by April 16, 1985.


In Reference (2) the Staff requested that Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company provide similar information concerning the Haddam Neck Plant. In order to allow for a coordination of response preparation for the Haddam Neck Plant and Millstone Unit No. 2, NNECO hereby requests an extension until June 5, 1985 in order to provide the requested information for Millstone Unit No. 2.
