SUBJECT: BOMB THREAT

Carolina Power and Light (CP&L) notified the NRC resident inspector yesterday that an unsigned note was found inside an employee "quality check" comment box. The note read: "Ten sticks of dynamite are planted inside the reactor auxiliary building elevation 261 and will go off at 5:30 p.m."

Those areas of the reactor and auxiliary buildings were searched and evacuated from 5 to 6 p.m. No explosives were found. CP&L did not notify off-site law enforcement authorities. Region II has informed the Information Assessment Team.

Shearon Harris Unit 1 is about 85 percent complete. No fuel is on site.

The State of North Carolina has been informed.
