## Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Greenman of this office on November 19-22, 1974 at Oyster Creek, Forked River, New Jersey of activities authorized by AEC License No. DPR-16 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Greenman with Mr. Ross, Mr. Carroll and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection, and to subsequent telephone discussions between Mr. Greenman and Mr. Carroll on November 27 and December 9, 1974.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Regulatory Operations Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you had taken to correct the violations brought to your attention in a letter dated April 2, 1974, following our inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of AEC requirements. The items and references to the pertinent requirements are listed in the enclosure to this letter. This letter constitutes a notice sent to you pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.201 of the AEC's "Rules of Practice", Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations.

Section 2.201 requires you to submit to this office within 20 days of your receipt of this notice, a written statement of explanation in reply, including: (1) corrective steps which have been or will be taken by you, and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved.
