Response

Corrective Steps Which Have Been Taken and the Results Achieved

The commitment to the NRC has been revised by letter No. RBG-19768, dated December 26, 1984, to permanently repair the damaged Division A standby diesel generator jacket water system exhaust manifold shroud prior to fuel load. The Director of River Bend Projects discussed the circumstances of the deviation with the Diesel Qualification Program Manager, and emphasized the need to prevent recurrence of this situation.

Corrective Steps Which Will Be Taken To Avoid Further Deviations

Of 59 Deficiency Reports reviewed, this was the only instance where a deviation from a commitment was found. This deviation is therefore considered to represent an isolated case. However, the Director of River Bend Projects distributed a letter No. SCRB-5981, dated January 15, 1985, to River Bend Personnel, reminding them of the requirement that individuals responsible for implementing NRC commitments should insure that the commitments are met or revised in advance of the existing commitment date.

Date When Full Compliance Was Achieved

Full compliance was achieved as of January 21, 1985.
