SUBJECT: EMERGENCY RESPONSE CAPABILITY - CONFORMANCE TO R.G. 1.97, REV. 2/  
NORTH ANNA POWER STATION, UNITS NO. 1 & NO. 2 (NA 1&2)

Your submittal dated January 31, 1984 (Serial No. 054) provided detailed descriptions of conformance to Regulatory Guide 1.97, Revision 2. The enclosed interim report was prepared by our consultant, the Idaho National Energy Laboratory (INEL).

We have reviewed your January 1984 submittal and conclude that you have provided an explicit commitment on conformance to R.G. 1.97 with the exception of those items which were identified in your submittal.

We have concluded that your justification for exceptions to R.G. 1.97 for some of the items are acceptable. However, there are some items for which INEL could not conclude that adequate justification was provided. The items are identified in the enclosed interim report.

We request that your response to the open items be provided within 30 days receipt of this letter. This matter is a NA-1&2 backlog item. In addition, you should provide any other comments if the enclosed report includes any incorrect assumptions or reflects a commitment which you find to be beyond the intent of your previous response. Following the resolution of the open items, a safety evaluation will be provided to complete this action.

The information requested in this letter affects fewer than ten respondents; therefore, OMB clearance is not required under P.L. 96-511.
