Administrative Judges Kelley, Bright and Carpenter:

On December 31, 1984, Applicants filed a motion for summary disposition on Eddleman Contention 224. Applicants also filed motions for summary disposition on Eddleman Contentions 240 and 57-C-7 on January 2, 1985. The NRC Staff filed its response in support of Applicants' motion on Eddleman Contention 224 on January 30, 1985. Similarly, the FEMA Staff filed responses to Applicants' motions on Eddleman Contentions 240 and 57-C-7 on February 1, 1985.

Mr. Eddleman's responses to all three motions were due February 11, 1985. He did not request an extension of time to respond, and Applicants have received no responses to the motions on Eddleman Contentions 224, 240 or 57-C-7. We assume that none have been filed.


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Administrative Judges Kelley, Bright and Carpenter  
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The schedule approved by the Licensing Board calls for rulings on all motions for summary disposition by March 29, and further reflects the "hope that the Board would be able to rule on summary disposition motions as they become ripe." Applicants' Proposed Schedule ff. Tr. 6840. Given that the deadlines for filing responses have passed and that Mr. Eddleman has not requested an extension of time, the motions on Eddleman Contentions 224, 240 and 57-C-7 are now ripe for rulings by the Board.
