Gentlemen:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letters of December 28, 1984 and January 29, 1985, which transmitted changes to the Callaway Plant Radiological Emergency Response Plan, Revision 8 and proposed 8A, respectively. Proposed Revision 8A was developed based on a review of Revision 8 which was discussed with Mr. M. Stiller of your staff on January 23, 1985.

We have completed our review of the submitted changes and have determined that with revisions 8 and 8A your Callaway Plant Radiological Emergency Response Plan continues to meet the planning standards of 10 CFR 50.47(b) and the requirements of 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix E. Based on our review we have concluded that the two revisions taken together meet the requirements of 10 CFR 50.54(q) and do not decrease the effectiveness of the plan.

Be advised that 10 CFR 50.54(q) also requires prior NRC approval of any changes to your plan which may decrease the effectiveness of the plan. However, if your safety review assures no decrease in emergency preparedness effectiveness, then changes to the plan may be made and implemented without prior NRC approval. In all cases, you must furnish copies of each proposed change to the NRC in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q). Since Revisior 8A is to be implemented on February 1, 1985, you should provide copies of this revision to the NRC by March 3, 1985. Also, any changes to the Emergency Plan Implementing Procedures should be made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix E, Section V.

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
