Gentlemen:

We have received a copy of your application dated September 12, 1984, which was filed with the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (ONRR) for review. This application amended your May 4, 1984 submittal relating to the definition of "operability" for the Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant Unit No. 1. A \$150 application fee was remitted with the September 12 application pursuant to 10 CFR 170 of the June 20, 1984 regulations.

Based on information provided by the ONRR staff, it has been determined that your September 12 submittal contained information which is considered as being supplemental to your May 4, 1984 application. A Class II fee (\$1,200) was remitted with your May 4 application pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22 of the March 23, 1978 regulations. Therefore, a refund of \$150 is appropriate for your September 12 application.

By letter dated July 23, 1984, we notified your Company that \$150 was due for your July 12, 1984 application, which proposed certain Technical Specification changes to provide an additional restriction on the Hatch Nuclear Plant Unit No. 2 operation during the LCO with one recirculation loop out of service. The requested \$150 application fee has not been received by us. Therefore, rather than refund the \$150 application fee, we are applying it to the \$150 due for the July 12 application. We hope this transaction meets with your approval.
