2 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Good morning, ladies and  
3 gentlemen. This is an affirmation, discussion  
4 session.

5 We had one item planned for this meeting.  
6 I'm going to ask the Secretary to walk us through  
7 the item.

8 SECRETARY CHILK: Before we do that, Mr.  
9 Chairman, we need to vote to hold this meeting on less  
10 than one week's notice, if I could have such a  
11 vote.

12 COMMISSIONERS: Aye.

13 SECRETARY CHILK: The one item, SECY 84-398,  
14 Jacksonians United Believable Energy Policy versus  
15 NRC, in which the Commission is being asked to approve  
16 an order directing the staff to replace the license  
17 amendment authorizing full power operation at Grand  
18 Gulf with a separate full power license.

19 The Chairman, Commissioners Asselstine  
20 and Bernthal have approved the order. Commissioner  
21 Roberts and Zech have disapproved and have attached  
22 descending views.

23 The order is the one that was distributed on  
24 the 24th with amendments by the General Counsel and  
25 Commissioner, Chairman Palladino and changes suggested

1 by Commissioner Zech and approved by the rest of you  
2 on Page 7. I think those are the changes that have  
3 been made to the order.

4 COMMISSIONER ASSELSTINE: I think they  
5 were the changes suggested by me, as well, but...

6 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Yeah, I thought there  
7 was...

8 COMMISSIONER ASSELSTINE: Rather than  
9 Lando (ph).

10 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: It was, it was,...

11 COMMISSIONER ASSELSTINE: Oh, okay.

12 SECRETARY CHILK: He had one also.

13 COMMISSIONER ASSELSTINE: Okay. Okay.

14 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Didn't mean, didn't  
15 mean...

16 COMMISSIONER ASSELSTINE: It's all right.

17 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Could you please  
18 affirm your vote?

19 COMMISSIONERS: Aye.

20 COMMISSIONER BERNTHAL: I affirm my vote.  
21 And, Sam, I had a feeling that my vote was incomplete  
22 and it's been confirmed as I look through my file.  
23 I do have some comments I want to make, and I may  
24 file those as additional views here on the vote,  
25 just so the record is clear on why I voted the way

1 I did. But those will be coming forthwith.

2 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: All right. Anything  
3 else to come before us on this item...

4 SECRETARY CHILK: I have nothing.

5 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: ...or on other items?  
6 All right. Then we'll stand adjourned. Thank you.
