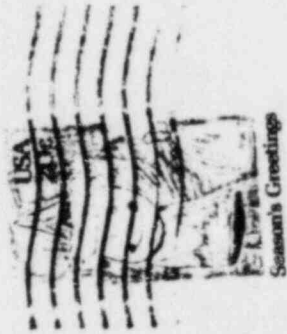
Even if Camp Wingfoot closes I will always remember the creeks running throughout the camp, one .
