SUBJECT: SAFETY INJECTION AND REACTOR TRIP

At 12:43 am (PDT) on February 13, 1985, a safety injection and associated reactor trip occurred, apparently due to a spurious high steam line differential pressure indication. The reactor was at 75% power for startup testing at the time of the event (incore flux mapping was in progress). Plant conditions were stabilized within 30 minutes. The reactor is currently being maintained in hot standby pending evaluation of the event and its cause. The licensee lid declare this to be an "Unusual Event" at 12:50 am and terminated it at 1:18 am.

The licensee intends to issue a press release this morning. Region V does not, but will respond to any inquiries.
